

## Travel Directions for the Jesuit Curia at 114 Mount Street

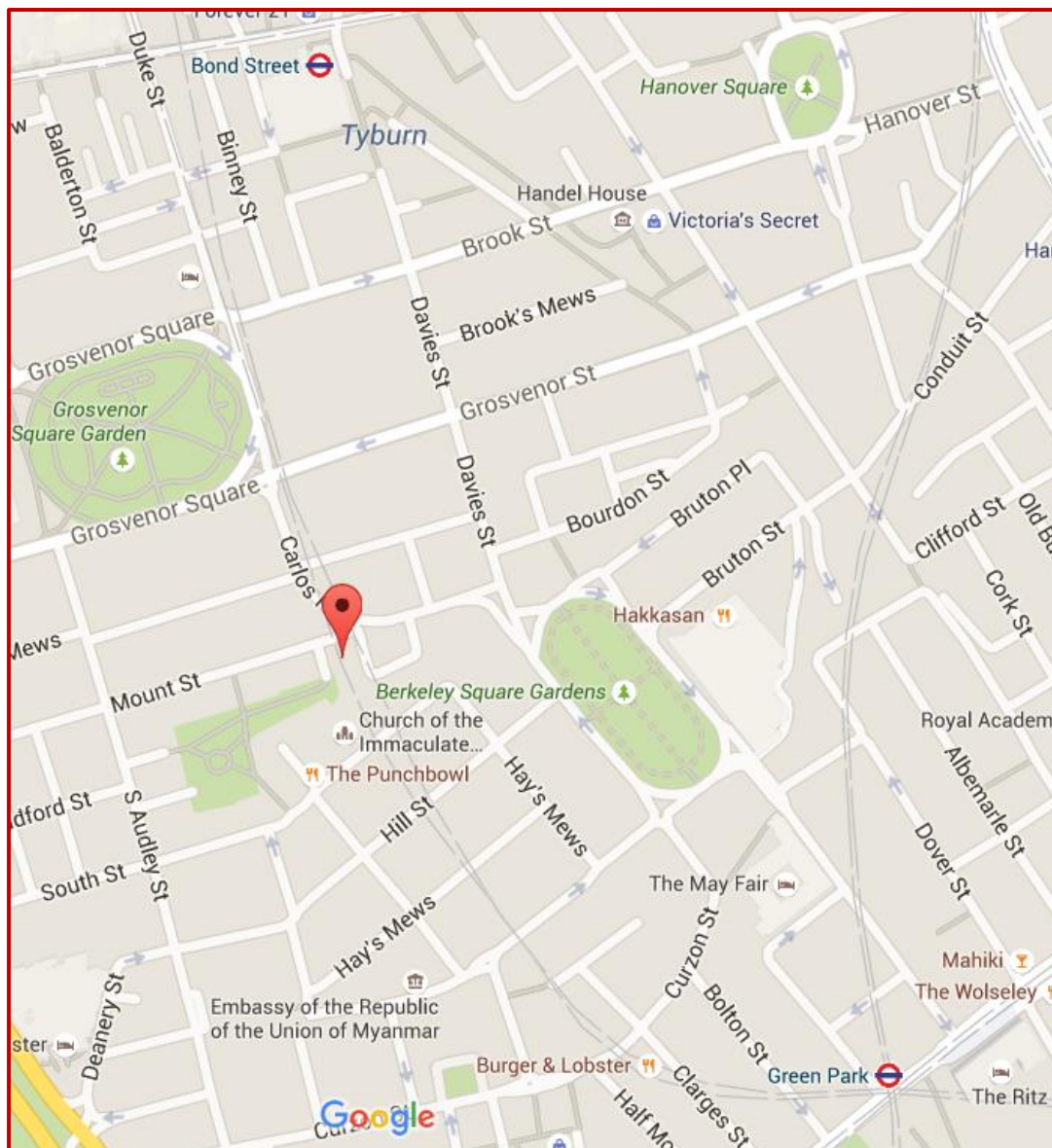
**Tube:** Green Park or Bond Street (both are about a 10-minute walk)

**Taxi:** 114 Mount Street is opposite the Connaught Hotel

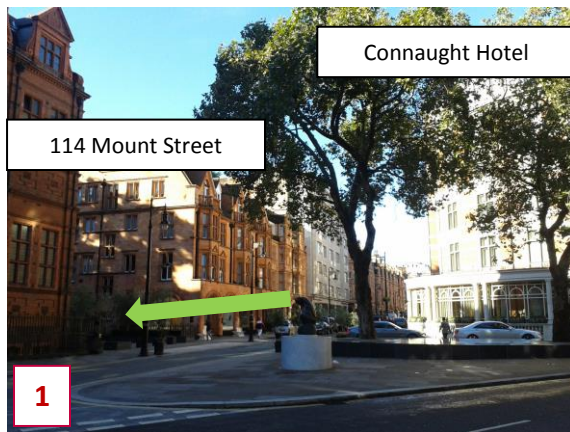
**Parking:** There is no parking at 114 Mount Street. The nearest public car park is Q-Park on Park Lane (Hyde Park). See the Q-Park website.

**Train:** to any of the main London terminals and go by Tube to Green Park or Bond Street

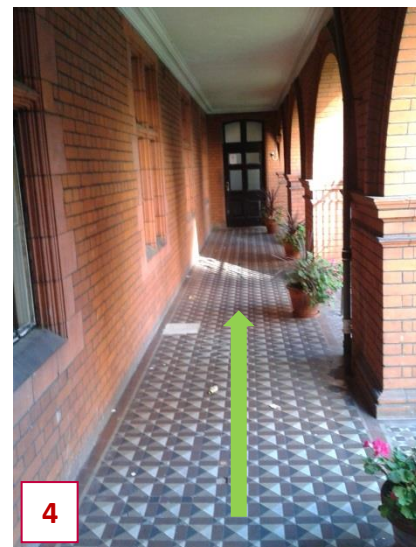
**Plane:** to any of the London airports (Heathrow, Gatwick, Stanstead), catch the airport train into central London and go by Tube to Green Park or Bond Street

**114 Mount Street** is a big red brick building in a little pedestrianised cul-de-sac across from the Connaught Hotel. The cul-de-sac leads into Mount Street Gardens (where you will find Farm Street Church – the Jesuit Church of the Immaculate Conception).



Upon arriving at 114 Mount Street . . .

1. Do not enter the black front door marked '114 Mount Street Reception' but take the covered walkway (cloister) to the right which runs alongside Mount Street Gardens.
2. Go along the cloister and through the black door at the end (which will be unlocked).
3. Go up a short flight of steps and turn to the left where you will see the signs for the Jesuit Provincial Offices.
4. To the left of the door is a keypad. Press **1** and the **bell** symbol and wait to be buzzed in.
5. Come upstairs to the first floor and turn right – someone will be there to meet you.
6. In case you get lost and need to ask, we are meeting in the Ogilvie Room.

If you find yourself in Farm Street Church: on the right hand side of the sanctuary is the door to the sacristy. Go through this door and up the staircase immediately to your left. Keep going along a short corridor and you will find yourself at the door with the keypad mentioned in No.4 above.
